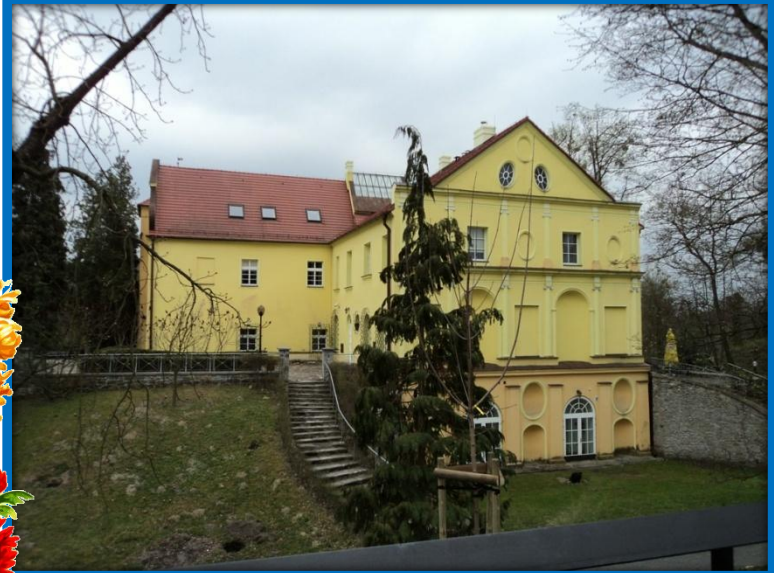

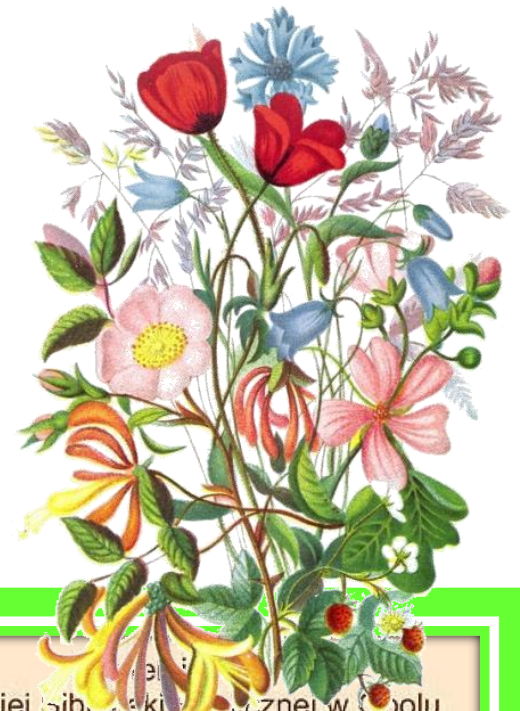

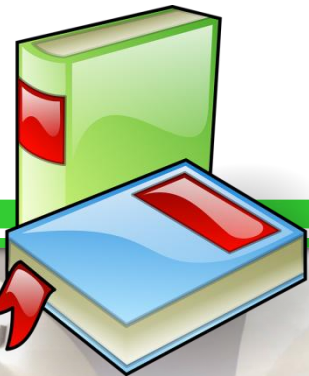
LEGEND RELATED TO OUR DWELLING PLACE

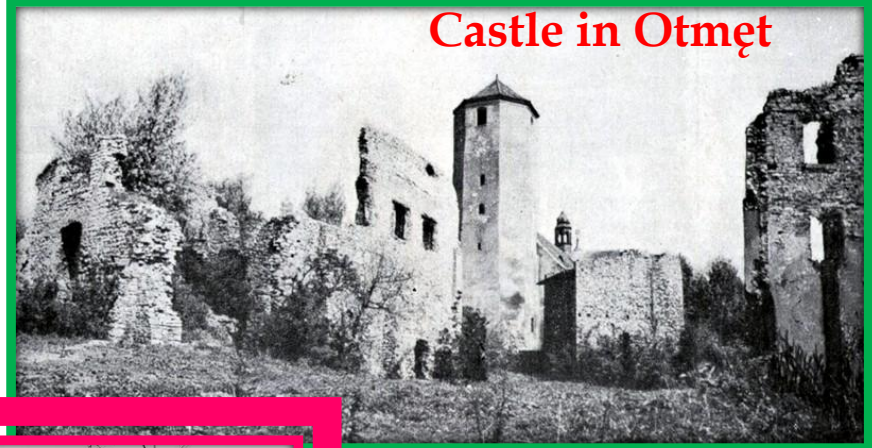




The most interesting information was the speculation that the castle in Rogów Opolski is connected with the castle in Otmęt and Krapkowice by an **underground** tunnel.

Castle in Rogów



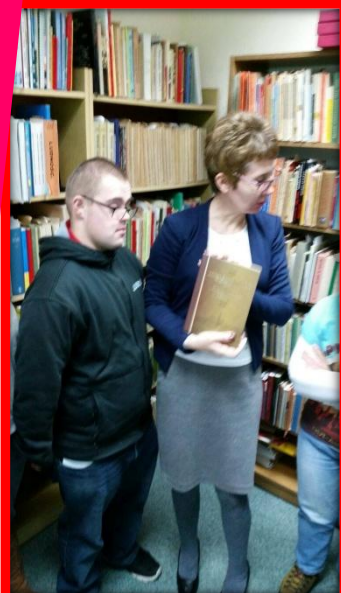

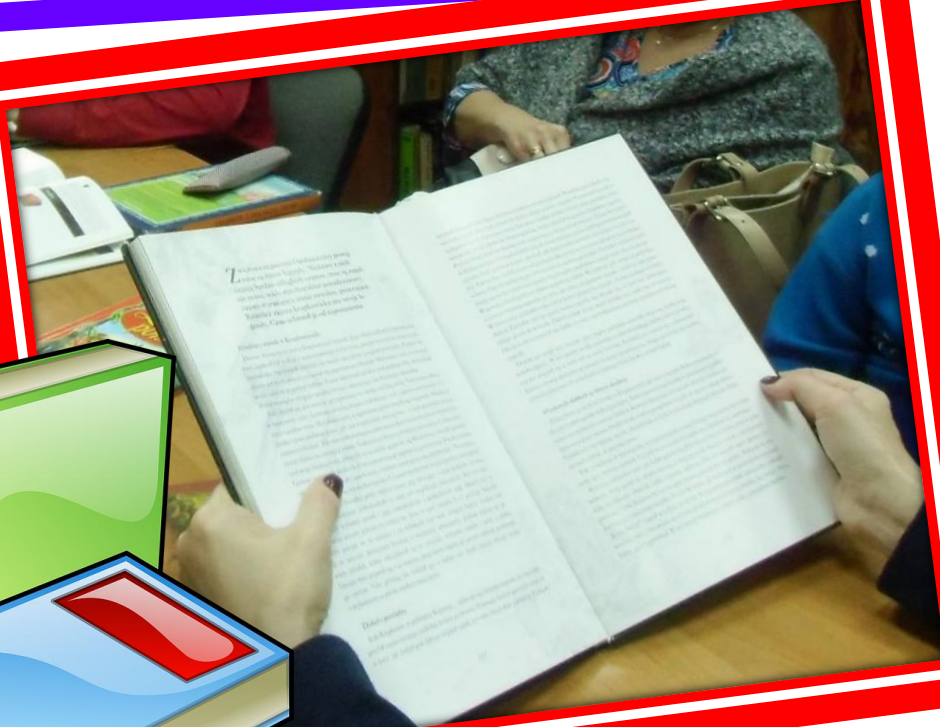
